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### INTRODUCTION

- Soft skills in student development are highly highlighted at Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM).
- To improve soft skills among students, Center for Student Affairs, HEP-UKM encourages students to organize or participate in impactful programs or activities via online or offline at the level of residential colleges, faculties, and universities in the country or abroad.
- At UKM, eight domains are highlighted in student programs and activities: leadership, innovation, sustainability, culture, sports, volunteerism, uniformed bodies, and moral values.
- All domains led to the seven soft skills evaluation criteria outlined by the Ministry of Higher Education (MoHE) Malaysia.

### OBJECTIVE


 To assess the relationship between student involvement and the soft skills acquired while organizing and participating in impactful programs and activities via online or offline at UKM. "Soft skills are personality traits, goals, motivations, and preferences that are valued in the labor market, in school, and in many other domains. They are a mix of dispositions, understandings, attributes and practices" (Yorke, 2006).



"Soft Skills represent a dynamic combination of cognitive and meta-cognitive skills, interpersonal, intellectual and practical skills. Soft skills help people to adapt and behave positively so that they can deal effectively with the challenges of their professional and everyday life." (Haselberger et al. 2012)

"Soft skills include communication, teamwork, problem solving, critical and innovative thinking, creativity, self-confidence, ethical understanding, capacity of lifelong learning, the ability to cope with uncertainty, as well as the willingness to accept responsibility (Kalfa and Taksa, 2015; Moore and Morton, 2017).










### Students' Programs Approval by Preferred Domain




#### **Further Research**

- Questionnaires was adapted and modified using previous questionnaires from UTHM.
- Questionnaires are distributed for 2 weeks from 22 November to 6 December 2022 online using WhatsApp and Telegram applications.
- A snowball sampling method was used by including a survey link and asking respondents to spread it to their contacts among UKM students.
- A total of 422 respondents were successfully collected during that period of time.
- The questionnaire was made in Malay version that contains 3 main parts: 1) socio-demographic information of the respondent; 2) intention to support impactful programs and activities via online or offline; and 3) 7 component of soft skills.
- The questionnaire contains 31 question items and uses a 5-point Likert scale; 4 items on the respondent's socio-demographic information, 3 intention to support impactful programs and activities via online or online and 24 items on 7 component of soft skills.
- Data were analyzed using the Statistical Package for the Social Sciences (SPSS), version 26. Descriptive statistical analysis focused on mean score.








**FACULTY**

#### **INTENTION TO ENGAGE:**


- 1. I am willing to support impactful programs and activities via online or offline if they have the potential to improve soft skills. (Mean=4.63, Very High)

Overall Mean Score=4.54 (Very High)


#### UKM programs and activities via online and offline are able to improve:


